On the roof

Village Lido - open May to September. Closed Mondays

Walk into village, walk down the back of the restaurant on the square, turn left on road, then right, then left at the castle style house. Pool entrance on the right.

Guadamar beach

From Daya Nueva take road to Guadamar, across the AP7 island, at the next island there is a Chinese restaurant on right. Straight over to next island, follow signs for town centre. Along the main street, you will come to a church on right, and square on left. Turn right at these lights. Follow road down to beach. Park up. Jamie and Mirimar beach restaurants are excellent. If you are facing the beach, to the right there is a promenade only a short walk away. To the left there are shady walks through pine forests. Guadamar market on Wednesdays.

La Marina - At Camping international there is a great complex of 6 swimming pools. It is 9 Euros for adults and 6 Euros for over 3yrs. A great day out, with sunloungers and parasols, and shady areas for a pram. Perfect for small children with lots of the pools having graduated edges into the water. Cocktail bar in water! There are cafes, or you can take a picnic. (Cool box and ice packs at the house)

Also the beach is fantastic at La Marina.

To LA Marina, take the road to Guadamar, then take the 332 towards Alicante. After Mercadona supermarket, take the right signposted La Marina Playas. Camping international a mile or so on right. For the beach, go past camping International. At traffic lights where there is ceramics shop on left, turn right. Follow road down to beach. You can eat at this restaurant, or if you turn left just in front of the beach and follow the sand track, there is a great restaurant down here.

Sunday Market at cement works.

Best access for double buggy. Take AP7 towards Torreveja. Come off at Torreveja North. On the right you will see the cement works. Turn right at the island at the top, towards San Miguel.
